SJSU Theatre Presents Original Play Based on Interviews with Undocumented Students

San Jose, CA... The San Jose State University Department of Film and Theatre's original play, "[dreamer] project: an undocuplay" premieres next month at the Hammer Theatre.

Created and directed by SJSU lecturer Kathleen Normington, it is a verbatim theatre piece based on interviews with undocumented SJSU students.

The play focuses on the continuing journeys of these undocumented students from Mexico and Central America, and the issues surrounding them as they seek to find a place to belong in the U.S.

By showing the challenges each faces as a college student, as well as their personal stories of childhood and family, we come to know them not just as "undocumented" but as human beings navigating an extraordinary time in our history.

One of the undocumented students who was originally interviewed was a Theatre Arts major who plays himself in the production.

"[dreamer] project: an undocuplay" will be performed 7:30 p.m., Nov. 15, 16, 21, 22 and 23 at the Hammer Theatre, 101 Paseo De San Antonio, San Jose, CA 95113. There are also performances 11 a.m. on Nov. 20 and 1 p.m. on Nov. 24.
